


Water Scouts

SPRING/SUMMER – July and August

Water Scouts help prevent the spread of invasive species on Lake Hopatcong by paddling the shoreline in specific areas the scout selects at least once during the early summer season and removing and reporting back on invasive aquatic species, particularly the water chestnut plant.


Trail Maintenance

ONGOING – spring & fall (recommended)

Trail maintainers make sure the Lake Hopatcong Trail remains clear and accessible. Activities include pruning, clearing, and making sure the trail is clearly marked. Maintainers also notify the Foundation of any issues such as downed trees or other obstructions. A training session can be arranged for volunteers without experience.

HAB and Salt Monitoring

HAB – June through September

Salt – November through April

Volunteers are needed to collect water samples and meter readings and complete data reports for Harmful Algal Blooms (HABs) and for salt monitoring. Training is provided. Volunteers will pick up and return equipment to the Foundation office.

We partner with companies near and far on community service days, working with the company's schedule and interests to tailor a project just for their employees.


Recent examples include trail maintenance, improvement projects at Hopatcong State Park.


