As we gather for our annual gala, our organization is working in many areas that will help define the future of New Jersey's largest lake. Projects such as large-scale aeration, expanded



sewer systems, and smart dredging continue to progress. In order to foster a better understanding of the challenges lakes face, we met with over three dozen legislators this year to facilitate long-term funding solutions. Just two years ago, shrink wrap from lake boats ended up in landfills. This year, 15 tons of shrink wrap were recycled thanks to a program developed and implemented by our staff. From our humble beginnings in 2012, we have grown to serve over 2,000 students from 30 schools through our 2024 spring environmental field trips. We also run regular public eco cruises each summer, offering unique opportunities for the public to learn about and explore New Jersey's largest lake. And this fall, we are excited to launch an inaugural high school program, further expanding our educational offerings. To support these initiatives, we need more and new equipment to "keep our boat afloat."

While all money raised through our gala and auction supports our environmental, educational, community, and advocacy programs. "Fund the mission" allows donors to address urgent needs directly. Microscopes

(\$2,200 total for eight microscopes at \$275 each)

Using advanced digital microscopes, visiting students get an up close and personal view of a variety of organisms inhabiting our lake. From plankton like bosmina and ceriodaphnia observed aboard the Floating Classroom, to macroinvertebrates like caddisflies and scuds found in the Musconetcong River, these microscopes are essential for providing students with an intimate experience with our diverse, small-scale world.



Tablets

(\$1,500 total for eight tablets at \$187.50 each)

Going hand in hand with our microscopes, these are the other necessary tools in showing our students the various macro and micro invertebrates that we find in our local water systems. The microscope might be able to zoom in on them, but the tablet is what displays them in all of their brilliance!



EnviroScape Watershed Models

(\$2,000 total for one EnviroScape & two carry cases)

A big hit amongst our visiting students and their teachers, the EnviroScape model serves as a way to teach about the distinctions between point source and non-point source pollutants. This interactive 3D model allows students to fictionally pollute, create a rainstorm, and see how their pollution on land washes through the watershed.



Dissolved Oxygen Meters

(\$1,100 total for 5 meters at \$220 each)

A crucial variable in the health of Lake Hopatcong (and all water bodies) is the amount of dissolved oxygen. With these meters, we can demonstrate to the kids how important it is to monitor this variable and how it impacts our wildlife in the water, from the itty-bitty plankton to the 3 pound bass you catch while fishing.




Float the Boat

(\$1,250 total for five \$250 fill-ups)

Without fuel, there's no boat ride! Help us provide our enriching and educational experience on the Floating Classroom by supporting our fuel costs throughout the season. 




